ANTIMICROBIAL STEWARDSHIP

Antimicrobial stewardship encompasses any activity that promotes the judicious use of antimicrobials around the globe to help combat antimicrobial resistance and preserve drug effectiveness¹

Support an interdisciplinary approach²

Reassess treatment when culture results are available²

> Support surveillance of antimicrobial resistance, hospital acquired infections and monitor antibiotic consumption²

Educate staff²

CORE ELEMENTS OF ANTIBIOTIC STEWARDSHIP²

Enhance infection prevention and control²

Prescribe antibiotics when they are truly needed²

Use the shortest duration of antibiotics based on evidence²

Prescribe appropriate antibiotics with adequate dosages²

Stewardship focuses on coordinated interventions designed to improve and measure the appropriate use of antibiotic agents by promoting the timely selection of the optimal antimicrobial regimen, dose, duration of therapy, and route of administration¹
